## Daily Tri-county Update COVID-19

### Peoria, Tazewell, Woodford Counties

All paperwork and fees need to be submitted for the year and all employees will need to follow additional new guidelines including face coverings and social distancing. No outdoor seating is permitted. Customers are encouraged to call ahead with orders and wait in line with 6-feet-apart indicators.
