

Process for Obtaining BINAXNow Antigen Testing Cards from PCCHD

1. Do you have a Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (**CLIA**) Waiver? If not, the link to obtain this is below.
2. Have you signed a Memorandum of Understanding (**MOU**) with the Peoria City/County Health Department (PCCHD)? If not, see the attachment, sign, and return to jstowe@peoriacounty.org
3. Are you registered for Research Electronic Data Capture (**REDCap**)? If not, you must first register for the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) web portal. If you already have this, the application for REDCap is in that portal. If not, see the instructions below, and when you get to the end, you will choose PCCHD and Monica Hendrickson as the administrator.
4. Let me know how many tests you would like. We will need to have you pick them up in the batches that you plan to use each week.
